- The KS 1 & 2 Aaloayrtys (Manx Gaelic & English readings, poetry & recitations) will take place in the Methodist Hall in St Johns, next door to Bunscoil Ghaelgagh and in St Johns Royal Chapel next to the Church. There will be stewards outside the venue to guide you in. There is plenty of room for coaches to drop off and pick up outside or at the Arboretum. There is a pedestrian crossing opposite the venue. There is parking nearby for cars at the Arboretum also. We will be the only ones using the building.
- Where a maximum of 4 students is permitted per competition, schools may request a qualifying competition in advance of Aaloayrtys. We can offer assistance in the form of an adjudicator at a date to suit. Please contact mfa@online.sch.im
