Category 4c	Outstanding contribution to Manx Culture by a group of young people under 25
Category 5	Manx Community Award: To be made to young people who have made an outstanding contribution to the Manx Community in general, either by their work for voluntary organisations or by their involvement with, and assistance to, people or groups of people, who require additional help or support.

Winners of categories 1 - 5 receive a minted silver medal kindly provided by the North American Manx Association.
